Formatting isn't just about aesthetics—it's about creating a seamless reading experience. A well-formatted book helps guide the reader's eye, enhances readability, and ensures your story shines without distractions. Whether in print or digital form, proper formatting reflects your professionalism, increases reader trust, and can even impact reviews and sales. Don't let poor layout take away from your hard work—give your book the polished finish it deserves.



Step 1:

Set your Trim Size and Margins

File → Page Setup → Paper

Size: Custom 5.5" x 8.5"

Margins:

- Top: 0.75"
- Bottom: 0.75"
- Inside (Left): 1"
- Outside (Right): 0.25"

Longer than 300 pages?

Add to the inside margin

Step 2:

Fonts and Spacing

- **Use serif fonts:** Garamond, Baskerville, Georgia, Times New Roman
- **Size:** 12 pt or 14 pt (depends on page count)
- **Format** → **Line spacing:** **DOUBLE**
- **Enable “Prevent single lines”** to avoid widows/orphans

Step 3:

Headers, Footers & Page Numbers

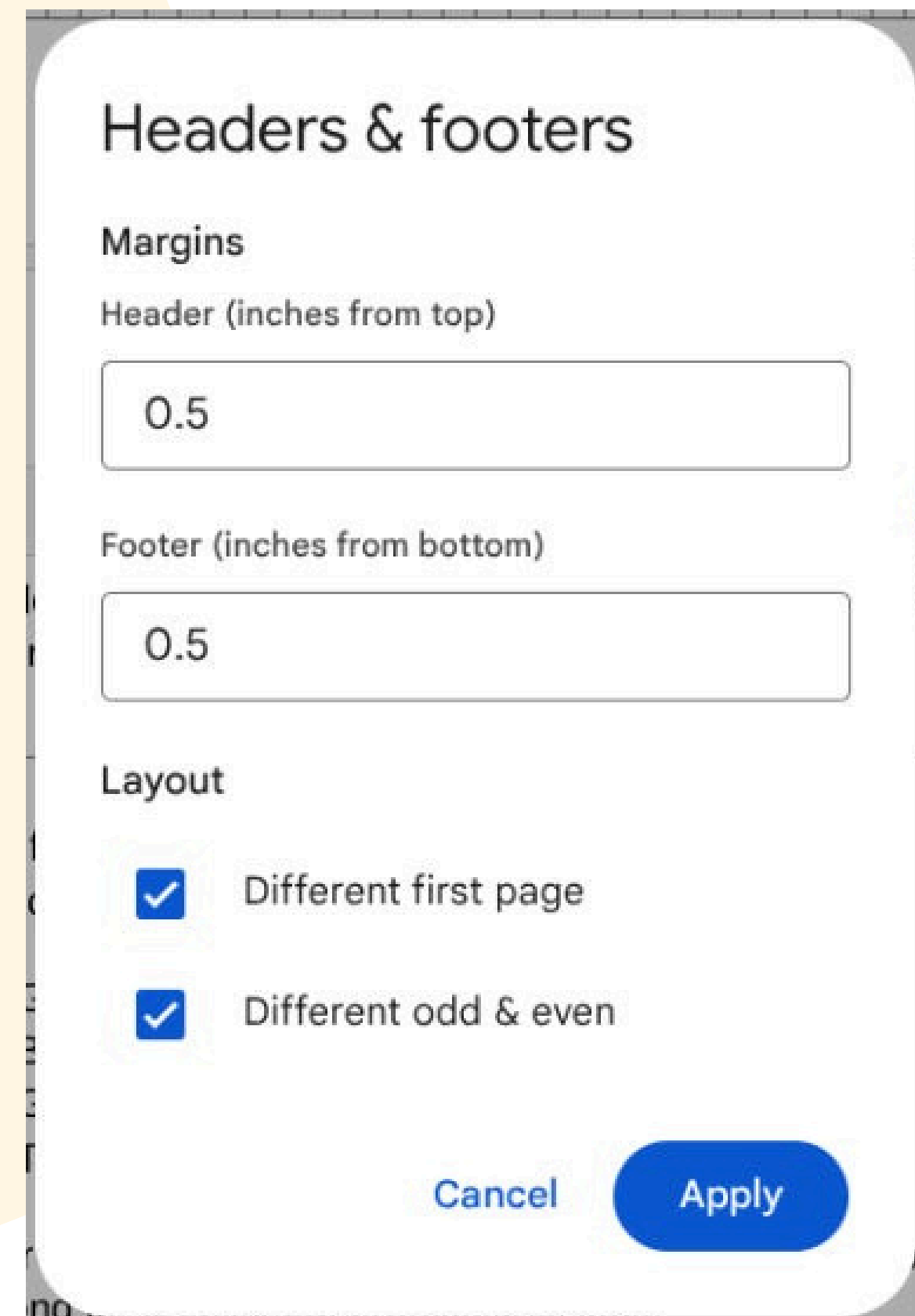
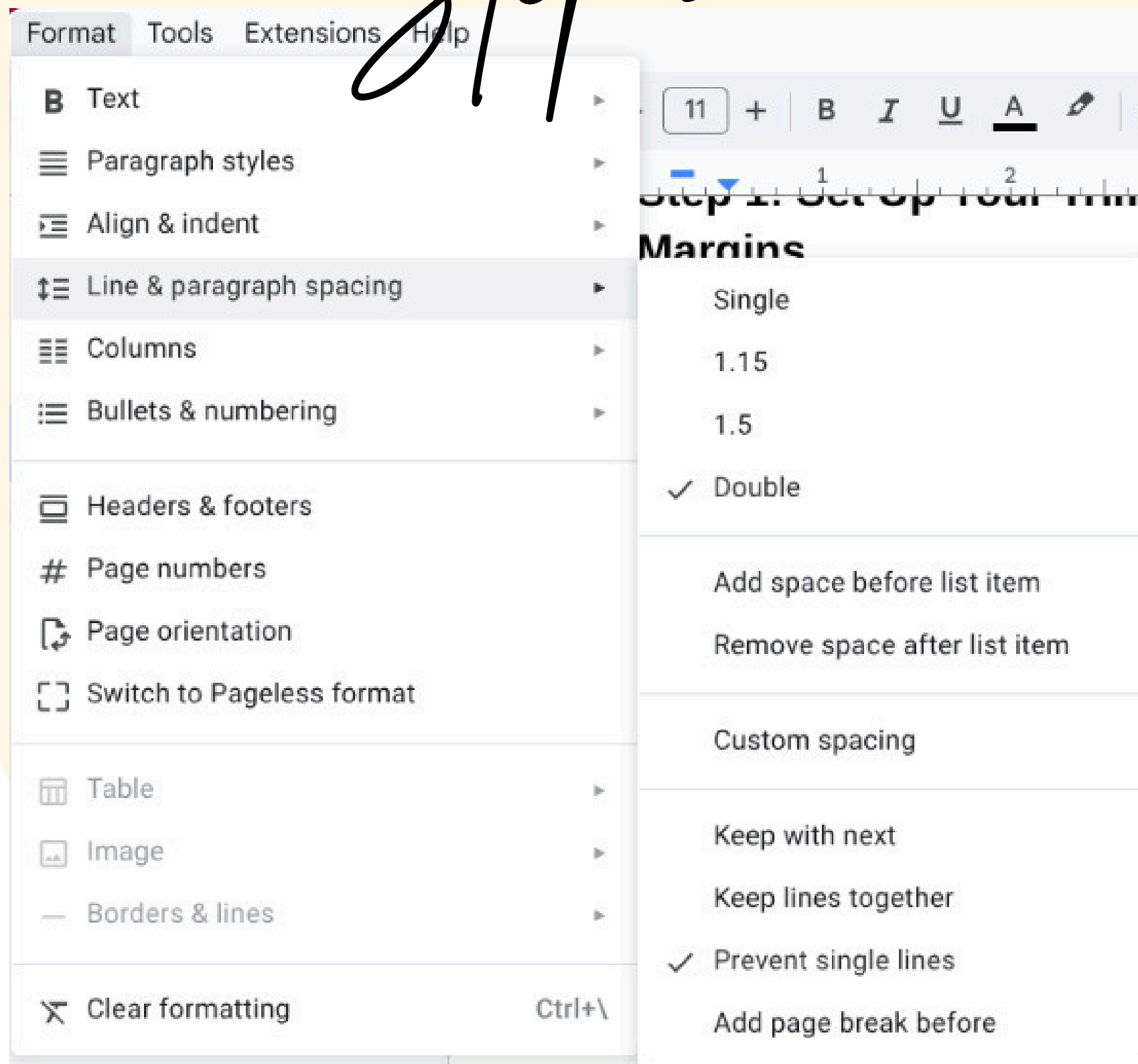
Header Setup:

- **Different first page**
- **Different odd & even pages**
- **Even = Author Name**
- **Odd = Book Title**

Footer Setup:

- **Start page numbers on actual story**
- **Turn OFF “Show on first page”**
- **Start at 0**

Step 4:

Front Matter

Title Page:

- Centered Title (36 pt), Author (24 pt)
- No header/page number

Copyright Page (10 pt):

- ISBN, disclaimers, edition
- Dedication: Optional & Sweet
- TOC: Insert → Table of Contents (use Heading 1s)
- Page Breaks between each section

Step 5:

Format Your Chapters

- Use Heading 1 for chapter titles
- Customize font size and styling
- Add a page break at the end of each chapter
- Always start chapters on the RIGHT-HAND PAGE
- Use left alignment (not justified)

Step 6:

Add Visual Elements (OPTIONAL)

Insert → Image

- Use sparingly (especially in print!)
- Color images increase print cost
- For custom breaks: use unique symbols for multiple POVs
- Test print settings with KDP or IngramSpark

Step 7:

Format the Back Matter

- **Acknowledgements** (Heading 2)
- About the Author
- Bonus content, appendices, extras
- New page for each
- Match formatting style

Bonus Tips **TO STAY SANE**

- Turn on: View → Show Non-Printing Characters
- Save paragraph styles as default
- Export DOCX for editing
- Export PDF for upload (KDP, Ingram, etc.)
